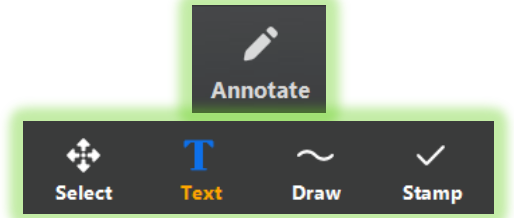

Enable polling (default setting)
