REAL CAMERA


- Full HD up to 4k resolution (depending on your device)
- Framerates from24fps to 240fps
- High quality data rates
 (depending on your app)
- External audio connection (via TRRS adapter)


Is it a real camera?

WELL...NOT QUITE


- Only one fixed lens,
 no optical zooming
- No interchangeable batteries
- No comfortable workflow
- No switchable memory card in the iPhone
- No tripod thread
- No vie wfinder

Common resolutions (by pixel count)








Smartphone production prep



Smartphone production prep

- Shoot horizontally not vertical
 - Think of cinema and your eyeballs
- Go into Airplane Mode
 - Reduces audio interference & pings
 - Will prevent interruptions
- Make sure to have enough memory and a full charge
 - If necessary, delete older photos, videos, apps
 - Battery packs can be useful for old phones & long shoots
 - Budget 60MBs per minute for HD video (3.6GBs/hr)
